 Rules: Non-timed format. Racers will complete 2 runs in the morning and 2 runs in the afternoon on each course. Number of runs and program changes are possible based on conditions of the course. 		
 No race suits allowed. Race bibs must be worn over the athlete's jacket. No pole hand guards. As this is an untimed and non-scored race, the program is subject to change based on weather and hill conditions. Any changes will be announced at the Team Captains' Meeting and communicated on race day through team captains. All U.S. Ski & Snowboard and NYSSRA rules apply. For details, please review your current USSS and NYSSRA Competition Guides. It is the racers responsibility to turn in his/her bib after the last run. Racers will be assigned the same bib number for the duration of the day. Bib collection will take place in the finish area after the athlete's last run. If a racer chooses to not complete all runs, bibs must be returned to the LMSC yurt. Failure to return a bib will 		

- result in a \$40 charge to the racer.
 All racers must conduct themselves in an appropriate manner. Unsportsmanlike conduct, obscene language or disrespect to race personnel, Labrador Mountain staff, or other skiers will result in sanctioning.
- Racers are entitled to inspect the course; however, they may not ski through any of the gates in advance of their run. Side-slipping is acceptable.
