Race Trail:

Frank's Fall Line, viewing area at the bottom of the trail below the finish shack

Racer Tickets:

\$25 plus tax. Racer tickets will be available from 8:00am until 9:15am at a designated window at the main guest services ticket window in the base area. Pass holders do not need racer tickets.

Spectator Access:

No discounted ski tickets are available for spectators. Those wishing to access the race venue via lift may purchase a scenic ticket for \$27 plus tax and ride the American Express lift to and from the race venue viewing area. Spectators wishing to hike or skin may access the race venue viewing area via Yodeler trail (please stay to the right of the trail).

Team Captains Meeting:

8:40am in the west wing courtyard next to the gondola. Bibs, coach tickets, and start lists will be distributed at the Captains meeting.

Lodge Access Information:

Stratton Resort has restrooms available at all open lodges. Racers and families should utilize the upstairs of Mid Mountain lodge during the race.

Awards:

Awards will be distributed at the Mid Mountain awards podium approximately thirty minutes after the conclusion of the race.

Stratton's Spectator Policy:

In an effort to implement SafeSport guidelines and maintain the safest race environment possible, USSS, VARA, SVC and Stratton restrict the race area (including the finish corral) to key personnel – athletes, coaches and staff. Spectators will be allowed in proximity to the finish corral only to the extent that these guidelines can be maintained. Racer live times and unofficial standings will be available in real time via Live Timing; please be aware that Live Timing only represents the data from timers and not the actual race results. Final race results are published exclusively with the oversight of the Race Committee and can be found on the VARA website within one day of the conclusion of the event.
