- Racer and coach registration will take place in the A-Frame.
- Passes and bibs are good for one day only. Bibs are to be returned at end of 2nd run.
- Discounted Group Rate tickets are available when voucher is presented at the Greek Peak ticket office (there is a one time \$5 RFID card fee).

8:00 Lifts open. NO pole guards, chin guards, shin guards for this panel slalom event.

8:30 am Inspection starts at top of Odyssey Trail

9:15 am Gate Judges, Ski Patrol take their places

9:20 am 1st forerunner on course

9:30 First racer on course

• Girls first then boys, start order randomized within gender.

(All times following are estimated—athletes should attend closely to the flow of the race)

10:30 (estimated) First run completed.

- Start order for second run will be reverse of first run with girls first then boys.
- DSQs will be radioed to the coaches.

11:15 (estimated) Second run inspection open

11:50 (estimated) Second run 1st forerunner on course

12pm (estimated) First racer on course for second run.

1pm (estimated) Conclusion of race; untimed 3rd run or skill stations TBD at Team Captain's meeting based on conditions

Awards ceremony on Trax deck approximately 45 minutes after event concludes (whether skill stations or race). Will announce via WhatsApp.

Comments and Notes

- Racers are encouraged to treat their car like a ski lodge. The first two rows of the back parking lot (across from Ski Patrol) are reserved for racers to tailgate/set up pop-tents.
 Packs/extra jackets may be left at the start area provided they do not block trail access.
- The main part of the A-frame is also available for racers and coaches to get ready/use restrooms. There are picnic tables outside the A-frame that can be utilized for lunch.
- There is no explicit health check BUT please do not come to the mountain if you are sick.
- NO late registrations.
- No refunds will be granted to racers who cancel after the start list for this event has be generated.
- Athletes will obtain their bib and lift tickets (RFID- see below) at registration in the A-Frame.
 No printed start lists or programs; start lists available via LiveTiming, weather and technology permitting (<u>livetiming.usskiandsnowboard.org</u>), programs via NYSSRA or AdminSkiRacing website
- Spectators are permitted outside the netting.
- Lift tickets are available to racers' families at a reduced rate of \$68 per day with a one-time \$5 RFID fee. (If you plan to ski both days, keep your RFID card and voucher so you can reload on Sunday for \$68 without purchasing another RFID card.)
- Greek Peak uses an RFID card lift ticket. Athletes must carry their RFID card at all times speed suits are NOT sufficient to get on the lift (recommended placement: tuck inside speedsuit at shoulder or in pocket if provided).
