Check In: 7:00-8:00am-Team Captain to pick up all Bibs/RFID cards for each Team under Large White Tent Behind the Base Lodge. Boys Second Run will immediately follow the girls

Start Order as per NYSSRA: Start order will use the TRS (butterfly) system.

TRS Looks like this:

Run 1 Random seeded within gender

Run 2 First run start list reversed within gender

Run 3 Starts with second half of first run order within gender and continues with second half of first run order

Run 4 Start order for the third run reversed with in gender.

Example: Run 1 1-2-3-4-5-6-7-8-9-10/Run 2 10-9-8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1/ Run 3 6-7-8-9-10-1-2-3-4-5/ Run 4 5-4-3-

2-1-10-9-8-7-6

Bib Collection: Bibs will be collected at the finish line each day.

Spectating: Spectating is allowed outside the finish area. If you choose to hike to view the race, you will need to purchase a discounted parent/sibling ticket online at westmountain.com

Parent/Sibling tickets: All parent/sibling discounted tickets (\$40) must be purchased in advance at westmountain.com.

Awards: SG and GS Awards will take place Saturday night at the awards dinner banquet for athletes and coaches only in the Main Lodge at West at 7pm. SL awards will take place outside behind the Main Lodge near the Fire Pit. The top 10 ladies and gentlemen will be announced, and the top 3 ladies and gentlemen will receive awards, and hard charger for each Gender. Team selection will happen on the last day of racing.

Timing: The race can be viewed on Live timing. Please remember results on Live timing are not official.

Protests: Must be submitted in writing at the finish building within 15 minutes of the posting of the referee's report, accompanied by a protest fee of \$50. Jury meetings will be in the timing room above the Race Building.
