No RFID card is required. However, please make sure your BIB is clearly visible to the lift attendant, and that you respect proper lift-line etiquette (alternate with public, every other chair etc)

Lodge info:	Store bags at bag check in lodge, get ticket from attendant to retrieve your bag. All athletes and coaches are required to store their bags before heading out on the hill. There may be some auxiliary bag racks by the elevator/ on first floor. Do not leave bags by tables in main lodge. The upstairs sitting/lounge area (not bar area) is also available to boot up, however that will be converted to restaurant space by 3pm. Please make sure to remove belongings by 3pm.

Bib Pickup/Registration Information:	Team captains will pick up bibs/tickets at lodge entrance (chair lift side) between 7-7:30 am. Only coaches are allowed through registration to pick up bibs. Inside of bib bags will be list of athletes you have claimed, their bib numbers, and a few start lists.
Bib Drop/ Return Information:	RETURN your BIB at the bottom of the racecourse or at the timing shack following the second run / conclusion of the race. You will be charged \$100 fee if bib is not returned. If you are looking to free-ski post race, please seek the front desk and they will issue you an RFID card to be used for the remainder of the day.
