racers, \$55 for racers 18-64, and \$47 for racers 65-79. Lift tickets for **immediate family members of registered racers** cost \$31 for 5-12-year-olds, \$59 for 13-17- year-olds, \$69 for 18-64- year-olds and \$47 for those 65-79. **Racers and family will need to show ID for** 

the racer and family ticket rate. IKON passes are valid at Snow Summit.

LIABILITY RELEASE: Online release of liability forms are to be completed when you register for the race at

AdminSkiRacing. Racers must have a signed liability release to race.
