Race Trail: The Gnarwall/Face; located adjacent to the new Quad Face Lift directly behind the Main Lodge.

Spectating: Spectating is allowed outside the finish area or along the delineation (tape or bnet). If hiking up the trail, a hiking ticket is required and must be purchased at the front desk before the race.

Parent/Sibling tickets: All parent/sibling discounted tickets (\$40) must be purchased in advance at westmountain.com.





Awards: Awards will take place outside behind the Main Lodge near the Fire Pit. The top 3 ladies and gentlemen overall and the top 3 U16 ladies and gentlemen will receive awards. A hard charger award will also be awarded for each gender.

Timing: The race can be viewed on Live timing. Please remember results on Live timing are not official.

Protests: Must be submitted in writing at the finish building within 15 minutes of the posting of the referee's report, accompanied by a \$75 protest fee. Jury meetings will be in the timing room above the Race Building.
