Please use On Stage (adjacent trail on the skier's left) for warm-up. Equipment and coats can be transported down the side of Race Slope by coaches using caution

No unnecessary movement on the hill will be allowed

**\*\*Coaches are asked to slip the course prior to awards. B-net on Race Slope needs to be rolled and taken down to the finish area.\*\***

Lodge info – use cubbyholes in Taconic, no gear on tables or floor.  
Leave skis on racks outside the lodge – nothing on snow near the lift.
