Bibs: Team Captains pick up at the UOP each day
 Athletes will turn in bibs at the finish each day—lost or damaged bib \$50, payable to PCSS.

Lift Tickets: \$ 30.00 /day (plus tax).
 Lift tickets can be purchased through ASR—**NO ONSITE PURCHASING of LIFT TICKETS.**
 Team Captains do not need tickets but **MUST** sign the UOP waiver via ASR.
 They **MUST also be current with USSS** **by the entry deadline.**

Waiver: found on ASR during the registration process.

Parking: Parking is free at the base of the Hyeway Lift in the main museum parking lot.

Tents: 10x10 tents for team use are permitted in designated areas at the base. **Tent Setups must respect all others in the area for ingress and egress.**
