- ELIGIBLE RACERS** U18+ Per FIS, USSA & Western Region Rules.
- ENTRY DEADLINE:** **February 9th, 2025**- A \$20 Late Fee will be applied after **February 4th, 2025**
- RACE ENTRY:** **\$60.00 per GS race and \$64.00 per SG race**
Entries per WR quotas. Foreign athletes must be entered through their National Federation, or athletes must have a Travel Letter on file with US Ski & Snowboard if a coach submits entry. In the event of a cancellation, the AdminSkiRacing fee is non-refundable.
- All Entries must be submitted on a FIS Green sheet Entry Form with an athletes & Coaches List to races@parkcityss.org and copied to Ali Holum at ali.holum@usskiandsnowboard.org
- ENTRY PAYMENT:** **ALL Athletes are required to pay entry fees online at: <https://adminskiracing.com/>**
- LIFT TICKET:** **Competitor Ticket: \$40/day- BIBS WILL SERVE AS ATHLETE TICKET**
Tickets will NOT be sold onsite. Athletes will not be given bibs until lift ticket is purchased.
- Coaches Ticket:** Coaches must register through the AdminSkiRacing portal and be included on the entry form to gain lift access. Coaches must hold a current Coaches USSS license/membership and register for events through AdminSkiRacing.
- UOP RELEASE & TIX:** **UOP requires a waiver (signed by a parent/guardian if under 18). Waivers can be signed on adminskiracing.com when registering either a coach or athlete.**

- VOLUNTEERS:** Outside club volunteers may check in for course crew duties during the day of the events. Checkin with Barb Yamada in the timing building to sign event waivers.
- AWARDS:** Race Arena Finish Area presentation approximately 20 minutes after the final protest period expires each day. Awards are given to the Top 3- per gender.
- BIBS:** Athletes will return bibs **AT THE END OF EACH DISCIPLINE and COLLECTED IN THE FINISH.** Athletes will be charged \$50 for missing or damaged bibs.
- DRAW:** **Seed lists and draws will be presented over a shared screen at the TCM Zoom call**
- RACE DOCUMENTS:** **Will be distributed to coaches on WhatsApp—no Scoreboard - Unofficial times & documents on Live-Timing for athletes/families.**
- PARKING:** **Parking is available with skiable access to the lift from team vans and cars via the Game Changer Parking Area**
