ENTRY DEADLINE: February 9th, 2025- A \$20 Late Fee will be applied after February 4th, 2025

RACE ENTRY: \$60.00 per GS race and \$64.00 per SG race

Entries per WR quotas. Foreign athletes must be entered through their National Federation, or athletes must have a Travel Letter on file with US Ski & Snowboard if a coach submits entry. In the

event of a cancellation, the AdminSkiRacing fee is non-refundable.

**Coaches Ticket:** Coaches must register through the AdminSkiRacing portal and be included on the entry form to gain lift access. Coaches must hold a current Coaches USSS license/membership and

register for events through AdminSkiRacing.
