

WELCOME TO BIG BOULDER IMPORTANT INFORMATION CONCERNING TODAY'S RACE

ALL COMPETITORS MUST HAVE A CURRENT US SKI & SNOWBOARD & PARA MEMBERSHIP TO PARTICIPATE.

COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS: Please stay home if you are sick and/or have Covid.

PARKING/REGISTRATION: Racers must have pre-paid and pre-registered via AdminSkiRacing. NO LATE REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED AND NO LIFT TICKETS WILL BE SOLD ON RACE DAY. PRE-REGISTRATION LIMITED TO 150 TOTAL ATHLETES (subject to any more restrictive rules or regulations if local or resort guidelines change). Parking is available in the lot at the Main Lodge. No parking allowed at Incline Lodge. Please stay in area to the left side of the Main Lodge lot as you arrive (see map). Racers may use Incline Lodge. Restrooms available in Incline Lodge and at Ski Patrol Building next to Incline Lodge.

INSPECTION: All course inspection must be done in a slide slipping fashion outside the course. No shadowing or warm-up free skiing will be allowed on the course. Any competitor not adhering to the INSPECTION rules will be disqualified.

RACE DETAILS: Today's race will consist of two runs. The 2nd run will be reset and 2nd run inspection will begin approximately 45 minutes to 1 hour following the 1st run. The 2nd run start time will be communicated to coaches after the first run.

BIBS & LIFT TICKETS: Bibs and lift tickets will be distributed via coaches at Incline Lodge. Bib Numbers must be carried or worn at all times during course inspection and race as the mountain is open at this hour to racers only. Lift Tickets MUST be worn on the racer to ride the lift. There will be no line cutting privileges. All racers must ride the lift designated to coaches at Team Captains meeting. Be sure to allow yourself enough time to be at the start in time for your run. Upon completion of the 2nd run, racers are to return their bibs just outside the finish area to the bib collector. A fee will be due from any racer not returning their bib.

COURSE: Once the race course is closed, no skier, except for the Race Jury and Course Maintenance Workers, will be allowed on the racing slope. No one is allowed in the Finish run-out area. Upon a racer finishing the run, the racer should exit finish corral and move immediately outside of the finish area.

SPECTATORS: There will be no skier or pedestrian access to the Big Boulder trail. The race trail is visible from the deck of Incline Lodge at bottom of Big Boulder slope. Spectators must leave a clear path for racers and volunteers/officials to pass to Big Boulder lift, and along bottom of trail. No non-racer tickets will be available at any time through the race committee. Any family members wishing to ski/ride on race day must purchase tickets via Big Boulder Mountain Resort on their own.

FOOD CONCESSIONS: Food purchase and restrooms available in Incline Lodge. Restrooms also in nearby Ski Patrol Building.

REFEREE'S REPORT: The Referee will not post a paper Referee's Report (Official DSQ List following each run), but rather, any such information will be transmitted via text to the affected racer(s)' designated coach. Time of transmission will constitute the time of Posting for purposes of the time within which a racer must initiate a protest to the Race Jury. The protest MUST be initiated through his/her coach by electronic transmission or in person accompanied with the appropriate protest fee (to be followed with a paper copy of Protest form). THIS MUST BE DONE WITHIN THE OFFICIAL FIFTEEN-MINUTE POSTING TIME.

SPORTSMANSHIP: Any racer displaying poor sportsmanship, foul language, or not abiding by the Rules of the Race Committee or Big Boulder Park Ski Area can be disqualified by the jury, or upon request of the ski area, without refund of race registration or lift ticket.

AWARDS: Awards ceremony will be held on deck outside Incline Lodge once results are finalized. Results will also be posted on Live Timing.
