Registration

Registration is available on <u>www.adminskiracing.com</u> and requires an active Freestyle Competitor membership. Registration will close at 11:59p on Thursday, January 23, 2025 <u>or earlier if the event reaches maximum capacity</u>.

Please arrive early as lines can get long. Discounted tickets are also available on Friday, January 24th for those planning to train at Northstar.

Free parking is always available at the Castle Peak Lots. Visit https://www.parknorthstar.com for more information.


Athlete Check-In

Athlete check-in will take place on Friday between 8:00-10:30a and Saturday between 7:15-8:30a in front of the Competition Services office in the Village. Sunday check-in may be in person or via the WhatsApp group.

Registration is located through the double doors opposite the ice rink. Athletes <u>must</u> have a competitor bib to access the course.

<u>Far West athletes</u> who have not previously received a bib may pick one up at registration on Friday or Saturday morning for a \$50 fee paid to Far West Freestyle by Venmo (@farwestfreestyle) or check.

<u>Visiting athletes</u> from out-of-division should bring their own to bib and check-in at registration on Saturday morning to confirm bib numbers.

<u>Friday</u>

8:30a Gondola / 9:00 Vista Chair - All Coaches & Athletes (No early load)

Saturday and Sunday

All coaches, officials and athletes may load Village Express at 8:30a (access from the Village) to mid-mountain and then load the Vista Chair to access the course on Hornet's Nest, with inspection starting at 8:45a. If you do not load Village Chair at 8:30a with the competition group, your access will be via the public lines at Big Spring Gondola connecting to the Vista Chair at mid-mountain.

**Athletes may utilize the competition line for the Vista Chair all three days if wearing their competitor bib.

Course

Hornet's Nest run is located off the Vista Chair in Northstar Teams Arena. The resort can be busy on holidays and weekends - athletes & parents are reminded to be prepared and plan accordingly.

Parents and friends can view the course from the bottom of Hornet's Nest. Please be mindful of ski traffic when spectating.



Run Orders and Lane Assignments

Saturday Singles draw will be run on Friday night with a last call for scratches prior to 7p on Friday night. First run will be based on a randomized, mixed-age order. Second run will be seeded based on first run results, with top 16 running first in reverse order, then 17+ to last.

Sunday Singles draw will be run on Saturday night with a last call for scratches prior to 7p on Saturday night. Singles will be set based on a randomized, mixed-age order. Sunday Duals draw will be seeded based on <u>Saturday's</u> Singles results. Duals will include a runoff to 4th place (round of top 4) for each gender. 5th - 8th place will be determined based on Round of 8 results.

Competitors may select red or blue lanes at their option for Singles events; lane assignments for Duals will be based on competition seeding.

Run orders will be posted to the WhatsApp group as soon as available.

Awards & Prizes

Awards and prizes will be given out on Saturday and Sunday at 4p or 15-30 minutes after competition completion at the Overlook Bar located above the ice rink in the Northstar Village.
