Entry Procedure:

Registration mandatory through Admin Ski Racing for Athletes, Coaches, and Officials: AdminSkiRacing Log-In

Race Trail:

Frank's Fall Line, viewing area at the bottom of the trail below the finish shack

Racer Tickets:

Racers must have their pass/ticket on them at all times, even after shedding layers. Stratton lift personnel will not allow racers to load any lift without a pass/ticket. A bib does not give racers access to lifts at Stratton. Thank you in advance for your cooperation

Spectator Access:

No discounted ski tickets are available for spectators. Those wishing to access the race venue via lift may purchase a scenic ticket for \$27 plus tax and ride the American Express lift to and from the race venue viewing area. Spectators wishing to hike or skin may access the race venue viewing area via Yodeler trail (please stay to the right of the trail).

Lodge Access Information:

Stratton Resort has restrooms available at all open lodges. Racers and families should utilize the upstairs of Mid Mountain lodge during the race; this area has been designated for racers and their families.



Stratton's Spectator Policy:

In an effort to implement SafeSport guidelines and maintain the safest race environment possible, USSS, VARA, SVC and Stratton restrict the race area (including the finish corral) to key personnel – athletes, coaches and staff. Spectators will be allowed in proximity to the finish corral only to the extent that these guidelines can be maintained.

Race Results:

Racers live times and unofficial standings will be available in real time via Live Timing; please be aware that Live Timing only represents the data from timers and not the actual race results. No changes are made to Live Timing after a run race results are published with the oversight of the Race Committee.

Awards:

Awards will be distributed in the main base courtyard or at the mid mountain awards podium approximately thirty minutes after the conclusion of the race. The location will be announced at the Team Captains meeting.
