Entry Deadline: Green Sheets by Monday, March 10, 2025 at 11:59 PM (PST) for U.S. entries. FIS rules apply for foreign entries. Entry sheets emailed to Chip McElearney at RaceAdmin@mrst.us. Entries outside of WR and FIS rules will not be accepted. Coaches must be on Green Sheets and complete online registration.

Entry Fee: \$60 per GS/SL, \$64.00 per SG race. Register via <u>adminskiracing.com</u> by Monday, March 10, 2025 by 11:59 PM (PST). Registrations received after Friday, March 7 will incur a \$25 late fee. NO phone, e-mail, or on-site entries accepted.

Lifts: Tickets for racers are \$60 + tax. Ski Race Athlete Tickets MUST be purchased online in advance at: estore.missionridge.com/special-events/products/mrst-ski-race-athlete-tickets

No reciprocal/exchange or discount ticket offers are valid for race days.

- 1. Before March 12, go to the above link and purchase your ticket. If you do not have a Mission Ridge account, create one and upload a photo, then sign the online waiver that will be emailed to you (*separate from the required race waiver*). Your new account and ticket purchase will include an RFID card that can be re-loaded for future tickets (not just this season). We do not recommend trying to purchase online tickets in the parking lot as reception is not reliable. Tickets purchased at the ticket window will dramatically increase wait times *please pre-purchase*.
- 2. Pick up your pre-paid pass at the ticket window. Do not discard it this ticket/card will work for future visits.
- 3. If you need a *replacement* Mission Ridge RFID card, go to <u>estore.missionridge.com/special-events/products/rfid-card-purchasereplacement</u>.
- 4. Racer Tickets will be valid for lift access on the day(s) purchased, to include night skiing (if available) until 9 PM.

PNSA Elite Passes will be honored. **At least a day prior to the race**, upload your Elite pass at: estore.missionridge.com/special-events/products/racer-elite-pass

Coach tickets: Coaches must be current USSS or FIS registered coaches to receive a complimentary ticket and venue access.

What'sApp will be used for all coach communication before and during the race, including official notice board communications. Invites will be sent to all coaches registered on AdminSkiRacing.

































Bibs: Issued in team packets to coaches at 7:00-8:00 AM daily in the upstairs of the Hampton Lodge, back left side. Bibs will be collected at the finish line after each race and re-issued the following morning.

Bib Deposit: \$75 charge per lost or damaged bib.

Gear Bags: please plan to use your car as your base camp.
