**Daily Program:** 8:30 - Lift opens for Jury Members, Course Setter, and Course Crew  
8:45 – Coaches check in for bibs at Rowmark tent near finish area  
9:15 – Athletes Load Chairlift  
9:20 - 10:00 – Course Inspection (entry to inspection will close at 9:45)  
10:30 – Start of 1<sup>st</sup> run  
2<sup>nd</sup> run will start 20 minutes after the completion of the 1<sup>st</sup> run. The 2<sup>nd</sup> run will run in the same bib order. Bibs will be collected at the finish of the 2nd run. Awards will be held in the finish arena 20 minutes after the last competitor has finished.
