**Run 2**: 2nd run course will be set directly following the completion of the first run.

2<sup>nd</sup> run inspection will start approximately 1 hour after the completion of the first run.

2<sup>nd</sup> run Course Inspection for 45 min

2nd run will proceed in the <u>reverse order within each group</u> 2nd run forerunners will run 5 min after inspection closes

2<sup>nd</sup> race run immediately following the forerunners

**Start Order** Mixed gender YOB seeding (1st yr U10s, 2nd yr U10s, 1st yr U12s, 2nd yr U12s) reverse second run within each group.

**Skillsquest** Environments will be set up on the hill on the way to the race venue. Each coach will be responsible for leading their athletes through the skills. Assistance with maintaining the environments is appreciated. More information will be shared at the on snow team captains awards.

**Awards** ceremony will be approximately 45-60 mins after the completion of the last run in front of the covered deck outside of the main lodge. Awards will be given for the top 10 for each gender.

## Rules:



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- All USSS and NYSSRA rules apply. For
- please review your 2025 USSS and NYSSRA Competition Guides.
- It is the racers responsibility to turn in his/her bib after the second run. Bib collection will take place in the finish area following the second run. If a racer will not compete in the second run, bibs must be returned to the LMSC yurt. Failure to return a bib will result in a \$40 charge to the racer.
- All racers must conduct themselves in an appropriate manner. Unsportsmanlike conduct, obscene language or disrespect to race personnel, Labrador Mountain staff, or other skiers will result in sanctioning.
- Racers are entitled to inspect the course prior to each run; however, they may not ski through any of the gates in advance of their run. Side-slipping is acceptable.
- Disqualification (DSQ) and Did-Not-Finish (DNF) assignments will be posted via AdminSkiRacing and posted on What's App after completion of each run. Any protest must be made to a jury member within 15 minutes of the posting. A protest fee of \$50 applies.
- If a racer believes he/she has been interfered with during his/her run, the racer must leave the course immediately, notify the nearest gate judge, then proceed to the finish area and ask to speak to the referee for a re-run. Reruns are provided on a provisional basis.
