ALL coaches, officials AND racers must reserve lift tickets through a Greek Peak Mountain Resort account ([create or sign in here](#))

Group invitation code **KGVDY**; PIN **0325**. Invalid use of discount code will be revoked.

● **Steps to procure lift ticket if you do not have a season pass:**

- Create or login to your [Greek Peak Mountain Resort account](#)
- Scroll to "Groups."
- Select "Redeem Group Invitation"
- Enter "Invitation Code" KGVDY and PIN 0325 and click "access group"
- Add ticket(s) to cart and **check out** (\$0 athlete, \$92 parent (optional))

- Visiting racer ticket and bib pickup in the Lower **Acropolis Room** in the Greek Peak main lodge
- GPSC racers will get their bibs at the A-Frame.
- All athletes, coaches, and officials must be listed on the approved NYSSRA List, registered through adminskiracing.com **AND** have a Greek Peak Mountain Resort account and lift ticket.
- Lift tickets (RFID cards) should be kept; you may reload your card for future visits.

 - 15 minute protest period after each run (\$50 protest fee, \$100 equipment)
 - Skills available in morning and between runs

Inspection for second run to start approximately 1 hour after end of first run.

Second run to begin approximately 1 hour after inspection opens.

2nd run will be reverse order of 1st run, U10 followed by U12.

Please help with BNets at finish of 2nd run.

Award Ceremony at Trax deck approximately one hour after completion of second run, in conjunction with U6+ open race.

Comments and Notes

- Drones are NOT permitted at the race venue.
- Packs/extra jackets may be left at the start area provided they do not block trail access.
- The base lodge is available for racers and coaches to get ready/use restrooms.
 - Racers and families may use the Lower Acropolis, Corinthian Room or the A-Frame as a space to get ready.
 - NO crockpots and NO outside/personal alcoholic beverages.
 - Picnic/personal food may be eaten in the Lower Acropolis. Do not bring packed food into the Taverna, Trax, or other restaurants.
 - Do NOT set up camp in the restaurants or at tables. Lockers and shelving in Lower Acropolis may be used.
 - Please do not leave packs/gear on unattended tables; put them on shelves or sidewalls.
 - Please abide by the Greek Peak Mountain Resort rules.
- NO late registrations and NO refunds once the start list has been set (on Friday, 2/28/25 at 4pm).
- All bibs are to be returned at the finish line of the second run.
- Greek Peak is using an RFID card lift ticket.. Athletes must carry their RFID card at all times – **speed suits or bibs are NOT sufficient to get on the lift (recommended placement: tuck inside speedsuit at shoulder or in pocket if provided).**

- Greek Peak is now a cashless resort. Bring a debit or credit card or use cash-to-card ATMS in the main ski lodge to convert your cash to card.
- Lift lines may be unpredictable. Do not wait until the last minute to get to inspection/start line.

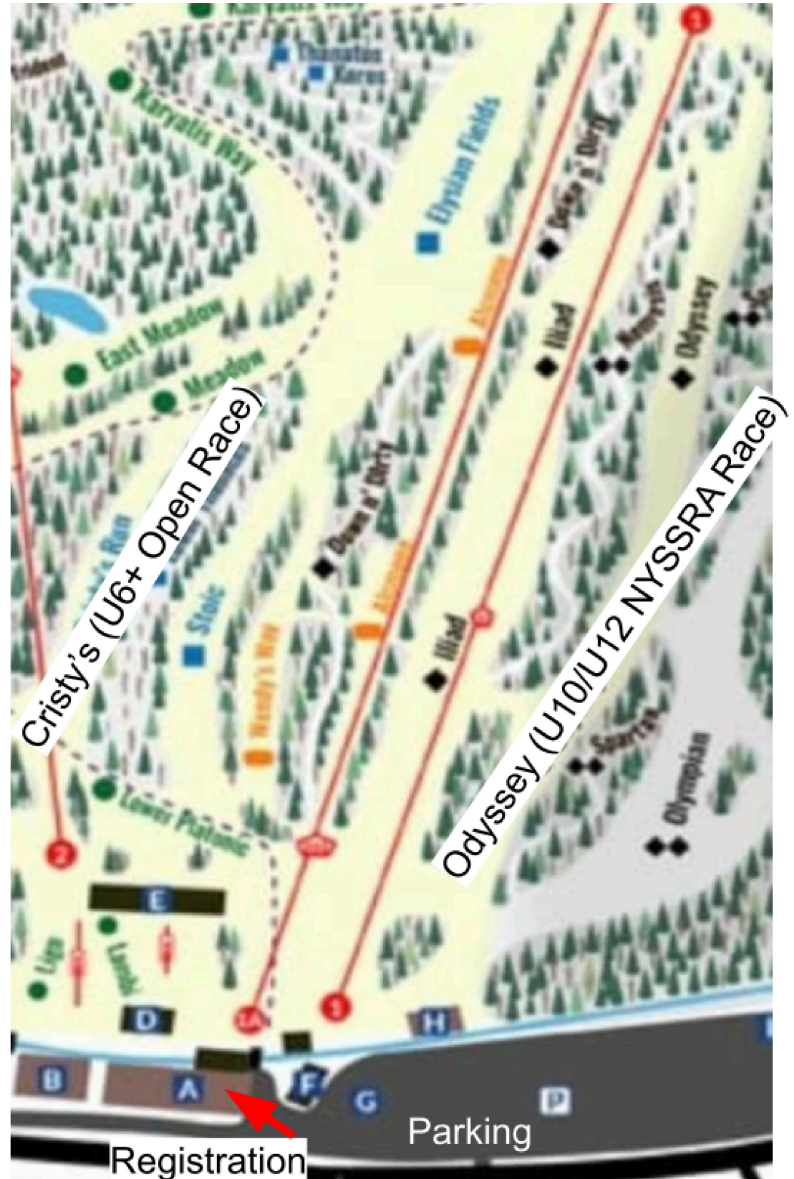
Athlete Safety
