Bibs & Tickets:

- Athletes should use the bibs assigned to them for the season for the NFSC Council Races

- All coaches must be listed on the approved NYSSRA Coaches List and registered through Admin Ski Racing
- Athlete and Coach Tickets will be given to each Club at the KBAC Training Center check-in desk in Central. There will be a bag for each club
- Clubs will be responsible for distributing tickets to their respective athletes and coaches.
- Any unused tickets should be returned to the KBAC Training Center check-in desk along with the names of the unused tickets to receive a refund.
- Day of the event, there will be \$65 tickets available at the Kissing Bridge Ticket Center for family members of athletes.

First Heat:

The first heat will run within age group and gender. U8, U10, and U12 Boys/Girls will be recognized. The order will be as follows:

- U12 Girls
- U12 Boys
- U10 Girls
- U10 Boys
- U8 Girls
- U8 Boys

Seeding will be randomized withing group and gender. (Note: The dual environment can be confusing, so we are going to let the older kids go first to establish a track and give the younger racers a visual.)

The first two runs, one in red, one in blue, will make up the combined time official results to be used for the NYSSRA and USSA results.

The Second Heat

The second heat will run within age group and gender. U8/U10s will be combined into one group. U12s will be the other age classification. Every racer will be able to run the second heat and will get two runs, one in red, one in blue.

The order will be as follows:

- U12 Girls
- U10/8 Girls
- U12 Boys
- U10/8 Boys
- The start list will be seeded within these groups by the combined time of the first two runs. Heat 1 DSQ/DNF will run in random order at the back of their age/gender grouping.



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The Third Heat

The third heat will run within age group and gender. U8/U10 and U12 Boys/Girls will be recognized. Every racer will be able to run in the third heat. The order will be reversed within age and gender groups from the 2nd heat with one exception. The top 10 (in group and gender) by combined times of ONLY THE SECOND HEAT will run at the end of their grouping seeded so that 4 races 3 and 2 races 1. There is no reseeding between runs. The King and Queen of the hill in the groups U10/8 Boys and Girls and U12 boys and Girls will be decided by the best combined time of the 4 qualifiers. The time will be taken from the third heat only. So, everyone is racing for good times and giggles and only the qualified top 4 can win the overall King/Queen. This holds true even if someone outside of the top 4 has a faster combined time in the third heat (qualifying matters).

For the top 10 in the final a DNF or DSQ will eliminate them. In the case that all 10 finalists DNF or DSQ the fastest finishing time will be the winner. For that reason, first run DSQs or DNFs are encouraged to race their second run.

Miscellaneous Rules / Policies:

- Interfering inside the course of your opponent is grounds for a DSQ
- There is no hiking in Panel Slalom
- No Chin Guards or Open Shield Pole Guards allowed in Panel Slalom
- Start will be "Red Course Ready, Blue Course Ready, Attention, Go!"
 - Racers must go on command. Any advancing or delay of start deemed to be done to gain advantage will be grounds for a DSQ
- If a course worker or other unforeseen circumstance causes a racer in one course to pull out, that racer ONLY may be granted a rerun as soon as possible in the same color course to establish his/her time
- Other USSA Slalom Rules per Alpine Competition guide apply, unless superseded by PSL specific rules

Awards:

- Awards will follow approximately 30 minutes after the 3rd Heat and will take place on the Central Deck
- The awards will be as follows
 - Dual / Council Awards:
 - There are separate awards per gender
 - U8 1st-3rd
 - U10 1st-10th
 - U12 1st-10th
 - King of the Hill:
 - There is only one King and Queen awarded per age/gender, 2nd and 3rd are NOT recognized.
- Summary: There are two ways to win! The official results with medals and council awards will be awarded for the best times in the first heat. The King and Queen of the hill will be awarded the fastest combined times of the 3rd heat after setting position using the 4 qualifying runs.
