Online Registration is required. www.admskiracing.com for all athletes and Coaches. Team Captains may pick up bibs in the DEN at 7:30-8:15 AM. Races will obtain their bib from the Team Captains. Payment will not be accepted and athletes that have not entered online will not start. All bibs must be returned at the FINISH following the completion of the race.

LIFT TICKETS: Tickets will be available for coaches, athletes, and workers only. Coaches must present a current USSA and NHARA membership card to receive a ticket. No ticket will be issued without current coach's status. No Coach who is not an ACTIVE member of USSA will not be allowed access to the venue.

LIFT LOAD FOR COURSESETTER/JURY/TEAM CAPTAINS: The Team Captains are invited to join the jury on the early lift load with the course setter and jury. The lift loads at 7:00AM. This load at 7:00 AM is a single opportunity to load until the lifts open at 8:00
