### Lift Tickets:

Lift tickets are available at Snowbowl Ski Area at a reduced price for Competitor tickets. They do not offer parent tickets, the course is walking distance from the base but I would suggest wearing shoes with good traction and bringing poles. Sunrise Bowl is steep and can get icy in places.

### Parking:

This weekend Montana Snowbowl is hosting the 50th Gelande Competition! This means parking can be chaotic, here is their plan to combat the craziness. *The main parking lot will be for carpoolers only (3+ people in one vehicle) from 8 am to 11 am both Saturday and Sunday. Anyone with less than 3 people will have a \$3 admission fee that will help support the avalanche center, or if they don't want to pay they can park in Lot 2 during these times.* Lot 2 is not too far of a walk, but to save time and stress ride as a team and be able to park up front!

### Lunch:

Saturdays at Snowbowl can be chaotic in the lodge and bar. MFT is going to be slinging hot dogs, chips, water, etc. at the bottom of the course for donation only! Bring cash or you can venmo!

### Registration:

All registration should be done online. If you have a problem, Paulette will be in the bar (The Last Run Inn) Friday afternoon to get it straightened out. Bibs are required, if your athlete forgot theirs, they can borrow with a \$20 deposit fee.

### Entries:

Entry fees are \$50 for each day of competitions. All fees must be paid online at registration. In the event a competition is cancelled, check the refund policy for Northern Division in the competition guide.

A course review will be held at the finish area for the mogul events after training on Friday. The draw will be held after training and run order sent out via WhatsApp.

## Awards:

Awards will be held immediately following competition each day in the finish area. Awards will be presented to the top 3 men and women for each USSA age group for both days of competition.

## Rules:

- The competitions shall be governed by the USSA Rules and Regulations for Freestyle Skiing
- Rule 3055.3 In Dual moguls a competitor will be given one restart for entering the course before the start command is completed.
- USSA license is required
- Registration is online only at [adminskiracing.com](http://adminskiracing.com) and will be closed Wednesday January 29th at 6 PM. If you have issues, admin ski racing will be able to assist you.
- The Dual Mogul event will be seeded from the results of a one run Mogul event held in the morning before the Dual Event.
