Race Trail: The Face; located adjacent to the new Quad Face Lift directly behind the Main Lodge.

Spectating: Spectating is allowed outside the finish area. If you choose to hike to view the race, you will need to purchase a discounted parent/sibling ticket online at westmountain.com.

Parent/Sibling tickets: All parent/sibling discounted tickets (\$40) must be purchased in advance at westmountain.com.

Awards: Awards will take place outside behind the Main Lodge near the Fire Pit. The top 10 ladies and gentlemen will be announced, and the top 3 ladies and gentlemen will receive awards.
