11am (or immediately following Run 1) Course Reset

12:00 Run 2 Start (or approximately one hour after the conclusion of Run1)

2:45 Awards Ceremony (or approximately 45 minutes after conclusion of Run 2)

****Awards will be given to top 5 racers, boys and girls, by age (8s, 9s, 10s, 11s, 12 + 13s)****

Run Order:

Run 1; Random selection within each age year: 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14; starting with Girls in each group followed by Boys (eg. 8G, 8B, 9G, 9B, 10G, 10B, etc)

Run 2: Same order as Run 1

Important Information

- We will be using WhatsApp for general updates and communications
- Athletes will need their bibs to load lifts
- Run times will be posted to Live-Timing as well as onsite scoreboard (bottom of race trail)
- DQ's will be posted at the scoreboard, as well via WhatsApp, following each run.
- No spectators are permitted on the race trail
- Racers can ski the entire area, but please stress to be aware of and respectful of other skiers.
- **SKIS LEFT UNRACKED AND ON THE GROUND WILL BE REMOVED**

Inspection Procedure

Inspect as TEAMS, athletes must be with their team to inspect.

Slip in and out of the course.

General Information:

- ❖ There will be NO race-day registration.
- ❖ Discounted day passes (50% off) will be available for family members. Purchases can be made at the outside ticket window starting at 7:30am. [Butternut season pass discounts only apply to regular ticket pricing, *not in addition to the race day discounted price.*]
- ❖ Racers wanting to free-ski following the race must obtain a lift pass at the ticket counter.
- ❖ Space is extremely limited in our lodge, please pack-up bags and gear and utilize storage areas when not in the lodge [unattended items will be removed].
- ❖ **Using cars and the parking areas as a base camp for tailgating, meals, etc is welcome and encouraged.**
