Race Trail: The Face

Check-In: 7am-7:45am Team Captain's pick up their team's bibs under the White Tent behind the Main Lodge. Athletes will pick up their swag and BBQ ticket under the white tent on the first day of the event during check-in.

1. Pole Jumpers
2. Freeski with Pole Usage
3. Straight Run to Side Slip with Edge Set

Awards for Skills will be at the conclusion of skills. Race awards are at the conclusion of Day #2.

Awards for the races immediately follows the race (see details below).

Spectating: Spectating is allowed outside the finish area only for this event. Uphill travel will not be allowed.

Parent/Sibling tickets: All parent/sibling discounted tickets (\$40) must be purchased in advance at westmountain.com.

Awards and Scoring (as per NYSSRA): Awards will take place outside behind the Main Lodge near the Fire Pit. The Top 10 ladies and gentlemen overall in each age division will receive awards for the race.

- Best 2 of 3 runs using place points of each run. Ties will be broken by best run then next best run until the tie is broken.
- If a tie still exists it will be broken using the athlete's best race points, then next best race points in the races contested.

A Skimeister award will be awarded to the top U10/U12 girl and boy with the lowest place points from the combined Skills score, GS run, and 2 Kombi runs (combined LOW place points total from 4 event scores). Ties will be broken by lowest place points, then 2nd lowest, etc. If a tie still exists, the tie will be broken by lowest race points of the 3 race runs, then 2nd lowest, etc., until the tie is broken. (4 awards total U10 M & W, plus U12 M & W)

Scoring Skills (as per NYSSRA): Combine all scores, 2 scores per skill totaling 6 results. Winners will be the individuals who have the highest score. Ties would be broken by best score, then next best, and so on. We feel this would be the best representation of overall athlete skill and promote development across all fundamentals.

Swag/BBQ Ticket Voucher for Saturday: All athletes will receive their swag and BBQ ticket voucher at check in on Saturday.

Timing: The race can be viewed on Live timing. Please remember results on Live timing are not official.

Protests: Must be submitted in writing at the finish building within 15 minutes of the posting of the referee's report, accompanied by a \$50 protest fee. Jury meetings will be in the timing room above the Race Building.
