Group invitation code GN1BQ; PIN 0325. Invalid use of discount code will be revoked.

- Steps to procure lift ticket if you do not have a season pass:
  - o Create or login to your Greek Peak Mountain Resort account
  - Scroll to "Groups."
  - Select "Redeem Group Invitation"
  - Enter "Invitation Code" GN1BQ and PIN 0325 and click "access group"
  - Add ticket(s) to cart and check out (\$0 athlete, \$92 parent (optional))
- Registration for ALL athletes will take place at the sales office in Lower Acropolis and only needs to be done once.
- All athletes, coaches, and officials must be registered through adminskiracing.com AND have a Greek Peak Mountain Resort account and lift ticket, with proper USSS & NYSSRA membership.

# Dining

Coaches & Officials: Breakfasts (bagels, coffee) and lunches (sandwiches) will be provided Saturday and Sunday in the A-Frame. Breakfast will be available at 7:15am both days.

Athletes & Families: Dining is available in the Katalima Lodge

- Each athlete will receive 1 meal voucher in their swag bag to be redeemed anytime throughout the weekend at EITHER:
  - Taverna good for 1 entree, side, and drink OR
  - Waffle Shack good for waffle and drink
- Greek Peak is a cashless resort. There is a reverse ATM on site.
- Dining Locations:
  - o Taverna cafeteria on main level of lodge
  - Lower Acropolis: Picnic area on main level.
    - NO electric appliances
    - NO outside/personal alcoholic beverages
  - Trax Pub & Grill restaurant on upper level of main lodge

## **Award Ceremony**

B-Nets must be removed before award ceremony - details will be posted on WhatsApp

- Join us in the **Acropolis Ballroom** (main lodge, second floor) shortly after the end of Sunday's 2nd run for more bib draws and awards. Athlete must be present to receive bib draw items.
- Awards will include recognition for skills (from Saturday) and race competition. Top 10 M/W in each
  age class (U10 & U12) for combined Skills scores, and, best 2 of 3 place points in the 3 race runs. In
  addition, SkiMeister Awards will be granted to top M/W, U10/U12. Awards for U14 top finisher M/W.

## Comments and Notes

- Racers: bibs are yours to keep!
- Lift tickets are good for the entire weekend, and can be used for future visits, too
- Drones are NOT permitted at the race venue.
- All races to use GS rules according to the <u>2025 Alpine CompetitionGuide</u>, including but not limited to:
  - No hiking
  - Hard ear helmets required with no spoilers or protruding parts (this includes Go-Pro mounts).
     Athletes must use helmets designed for GS in Kombi. See page 150 of Alpine Guide for more information.
  - No wax benches in race arena; no wax application in competition venue
  - Athlete must have only one set of skis at venue at a time

- Packs/extra jackets may be left at the start area provided they do not block trail access.
- There is no scoreboard for this race. WhatsApp will serve as the Official Notice Board.
- The base lodge is available for racers, coaches, families to get ready/use restrooms.
  - Do not leave packs/gear on unattended tables; put them on shelves or sidewalls.
  - o There is no reserving of tables.
- Please abide by the Greek Peak Mountain Resort rules.
- Greek Peak is using an RFID card lift ticket. Athletes must carry their RFID card at all times speed suits or bibs are NOT sufficient to get on the lift
- Greek Peak is now a cashless resort. Bring a debit or credit card or use cash-to-card ATMS in the main ski lodge to convert your cash to card.
- Lift lines may be unpredictable, please plan accordingly.
- All skis and equipment MUST be picked up and placed on racks when not on your feet.
- We will comply fully with health and safety protocols established by New York State, Cortland County, US Ski & Snowboard, NYSSRA, Greek Peak Mountain Resort, and the Greek Peak Ski Club.

# Athlete Safety
