- Race Trail: Snake Bite (Racers should use Sterling Lift) – Start @ FIS SL Start (4 gates above Pitch)
- Single Panel Giant Slalom
- 2 runs Men & Women (running order U12 Women, U12 Men, U14 Women, U14 Men)
 - 1st run – Random Order
 - 2nd run – Reverse Bib order from 1st run (within each age and gender category)

Registration, Bib Pickup, Lodge Space: Coaches, please collect your bibs and tickets from registration out the SNSC Clubhouse between 7:30-8:30 AM. The **entry fee will be \$50**, and all athletes must register and pay online at www.admskiracing.com. Online registration is open from 5:00 PM on March 10th and closes 12:00 Noon on March 15th. Athlete can us Madonna Base Lodge and Parking lot 1 Yurt to boot up. SNSC yurt can be used to warm-up only.

Directions to Smugglers: Smugglers Notch is located on route 108 S. The only access is from the North during the winter since the notch road is closed. From Route 15 you turn onto route 108 S in Jeffersonville and follow it up to the Smugglers Notch Resort. To get to the upper mountain you continue past the main entrance to the resort up route 108. Parking will be on your right and the driveway to the base lodge will be on your left. If you wish you can continue past these options to the upper parking lot which is around the corner up to where the notch road is closed (this is ski in and out access only)

Parking: Parking is available in the two main lots across from the base lodge driveway. The Upper Parking lot is available for racers or coaches that want to ski from their car and ski back to it at the end of the day. Please don't park in the club member parking lot at the end of our driveway.

Other Information: Please keep the trail in front of the SNSC clubhouse clear of people and skis. Please make sure all skis are place on racks. Please lower safety bars while riding lifts. Do not weave on the T-Bar, and stay in the tracks under the cable. No Dogs allowed on the hill, please leave them at home.

Medical Plan:

Smuggler's Notch Ski Patrol are first response trained.

The Ski Patrol building at the top of Sterling Lift is manned at all times with at least two patrollers and will respond to any need on the race venue.

Sterling Patrol response time to the race venue is 5 minutes max.

If patrol is needed, the chief of race will contact patrol via radio or cell phone, at this point the race will be placed on hold and will remain on hold until patrol has cleared the venue.

Minor injuries requiring first aid only will be handled by Smugglers' Notch Ski Patrol in the first aid station in the Madonna Base Lodge. There is a "Stop the Bleed" kit located at the start.

If an ambulance service is needed Patrol will contact Cambridge Rescue. Response time is 12 Minutes.

Transport Time to the University of Vermont Medical Center (Fletcher Allen) in Burlington is 45 minutes to 60 minutes.

Transport time to Copley Hospital in Morrisville is 40 minutes to 45 minutes.

If Cambridge Rescue determines that air transportation is required Dartmouth Flight For Life will be utilized. Flight time to landing are is twenty to thirty minutes in good weather.

Flight time to University of Vermont Medical Center (Fletcher Allen) in Burlington is 10 Minutes to 15 Minutes.

Flight Time to Dartmouth-Hitchcock is Twenty minutes to Thirty minutes.
