No late entries will be accepted.

TEAM CAPTAIN'S MEETING	Thursday, April 4th, 2025, at 4:00 pm PST. This will be a Teams meeting. The link will be given out to all coaches registered. All coaches need to register for the event via online registration no later than Sunday, March 30 2025, by 11:59pm.
LIFT TICKETS	Lift tickets can be purchased at the Season pass office located in the Northstar village, open at 7:45 AM. Athlete Event Day lift tickets for 13 years of age and up will be \$62 and for 12 years of age and under will be \$43. An Additional waiver will need to be signed at the ticket office. The lift ticket prices for parents/ Non racers who would like to spectate during the event. Ticket Prices: \$79 adults, \$62 teen & senior, \$43 child, \$30 gondola spectator/non-skier. <u><i>These will be available at the ticket office when you purchase the Athletes tickets for race days only.</i></u>
SCHEDULE	Saturday and Sunday April 5-6, 2025 Tahoe League Race Series Specific event schedules will be released at the coaches meeting on April 4 th .
BIBS	Bib pickup will be at 7:15AM and located in the competition services office located next to the Northstar Sports Demo Center. Alpine coaches will pick up bibs and distribute them to their athletes for each race and return at the end of the weekend. Teams will be charged \$50 fee for any non-returned bib.
AWARDS	The Awards will be hosted at the Overlook located in the Upper level of the Northstar Village above the ice rink.
