Entry Deadline:

Registration for all entries closes Tuesday March 18, 2025, 11:59 PM. A late fee of \$40 will apply after Saturday March 15, 2025. No late entries accepted. Coaches and officials are required to register by March 16, 2025, at <u>adminskiracing.com</u>
