All race registration MUST be done through AdminSkiRacing, the event listing is <u>HERE</u>. There will be no on-site registration or day of race payment. There are no guaranteed refunds once race registration closes. Online registration will be open until noon on Friday, January 2, 2026. Entry fee is \$75. The athlete's bib is their lift ticket to the race hill.

All participants must be current alpine competitor members of U.S. Ski & Snowboard to compete.

Bibs will be handed out to club coaches for distribution at the Bromley Outing Club second floor offices from 7-8 am on race day. Coach tickets will be handed out there – make sure all coaches are signed up on www.adminskiracing.com.

Parent ticket vouchers are available at the BOC clubhouse. Parent tickets are \$104+tax – vouchers are redeemed at the ticket window.

The racecourse is set on East Meadow – accessed by the Alpine Chairlift. The start is to the right when leaving the lift. Lifts open at 8:30 am. Inspection opens at 8:45 to 9:15 am.

First run women will start at 9:30 AM, followed by the men. Second run will be run within 60 minutes of the completion of the men's first run.

Announcements, DQ's and DNF's will be updated on WhatsApp coaches link with the fifteen-minute protest window.

Bib return: at the Bromley Outing Club Clubhouse in the base area (at the bottom of the East Meadow), at the bottom of the main stairs. There is a \$50 charge for non-returned bibs.

Awards for the race will be in front of the Bromley Outing Club after completion of the race, time will be announced to coaches via WhatsApp.

It is imperative that your athletes ski SLOWLY through the base area, we are on and adjacent to Bromley's beginner areas and anything other than slow, controlled skiing in the base area will not be tolerated.

All parking is in the lot located through the tunnel under Vermont Route 11. There is no leaving your vehicle while in the unloading area – all unloading must be done at the unloading zone in front of the flagpoles.
