**Race Date:** January 25, 2026

**Race Name:** Einar Aas Memorial GS

**Race Location:** Main Street Trail

**Trail Usage:** Main Street will be closed to the public before and during the race.

- Closing Locations
  1. Crosstown
  2. Twist cutoff
  3. Corridor will be set up from Tower 8 heading to Chute/Nuthatch for racers & support personnel

**Patrol Sled Location for Race:**

1. Patrol toboggan with backboard locations:
  - Top of Tri State Race Course
  - Top of Chair 2/Top of Main Street

**Emergency Medical Response:**

- Butternut Ski Patrol will randomly patrol the Race Course
- If manpower permits, Ski Patrol will be standing by on course.
- Ski Patrol will be manning Top Building and Patrol Base for duration of race.
- All Ski Patrol members are members of the National Ski Patrol and are all currently certified in Outdoor Emergency Care (OEC), Outdoor Emergency Transportation (OET), and healthcare provide CPR/AED.
- Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) are located Top of Chairs 1 & 3, Ski Patrol Base, and Upper & Lower Lodges.
- Stop the Bleed kits are at the top and in the Timing Building.

**Ambulance Service:**

- BLS & ALS provided by Southern Berkshire Volunteer Ambulance.
- Dispatched by Ski Patrol Base.

**Hospitals:**

1. Fairview Hospital – 2.5 miles away
2. Berkshire Medical Center Level 2 Trauma – 19.5 miles away
3. Bay State Medical Center Level 1 Trauma – 37 miles away
4. Albany Medical Center Level 1 Trauma – 40 miles away
