**PARKING:** Free Parking is available at the Hidden Valley Resort. Park on the front/Valley side.

**REGISTRATION:** On-line registration available through <a href="www.adminskiracing.com">www.adminskiracing.com</a>. Online registration will close three (3) days prior to the event. On-site registration will <a href="NOT">NOT</a> be available. The registration fee is \$60.

U16, U14, and U12 athletes will have the first opportunity to register—remaining spots will be made available to U10 athletes beginning January 28, 2026.

**REFUND POLICY:** Registration fee will be refunded to all athletes who do not compete. The race secretary attempts to process refunds within a week of the race.

**LIFT TICKETS:** Event registration does not include a lift ticket. Hidden Valley honors corresponding Epic passes. Registered athletes that do not have an Epic pass may purchase competition day-passes at a discounted rate from the Hidden Valley ticket office at the main lodge (the Valley Side of the resort) on the morning of the race. 2nd Run Start – 5 minutes after start of forerunners

Start Order:

- 1. Women Non-scored
- 2. Men Non-Scored
- 3. Women Scored
- 4. Men Scored

Non-scored Race Seeding:

Run 1 - Randomize within Gender / Age Group. Run younger age groups first.

Run 2 - Reverse Run 1 within Gender / Age Group

Scored Race Seeding:

Run 1 - Top 15 are listed in point order, then randomized. Ties within points and 999 point holders will be randomized.

Run 2 - Top 30 fastest times are reversed. Remainder of the field runs fastest to slowest.

**Equipment Rules**: For scored races, competition equipment may be subject to a controlled inspection. For non-scored races, equipment violations will be handled on a protest basis only. Equipment violations will be subject to disgualification. For non-scored races, equipment violations will be handled on a protest basis only.
