<b>Entries</b>	<b>\$43.00 per Race and \$35 for the Mandatory Speed training day. Race Tickets Are Sold Separately.</b> All entries must be done online; for online registration please visit <a href="#">AdminSkiRacing   America's largest ski race and event platform</a> . <b>Registration will open February 7<sup>th</sup>, 2026.</b>
<b>Entry Deadline</b>	<b>11:59pm Sunday, March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026, is the deadline for registration.</b> <b><u>\$40.00 Late fee will be applied after the Sunday deadline until 11:59pm Wednesday, March 4<sup>th</sup>, 2026.</u></b> No entries are accepted after the March 4 <sup>th</sup> deadline. <b>(Coaches need to sign up by this date)</b>  <b><u>Any pulls past the entry deadline must go through the race organizer (Northstar) <a href="mailto:northstarracedept@vailresort.com">northstarracedept@vailresort.com</a> No late entries will be accepted.</u></b>

<b>Liability Release Form</b>	Release of Liability forms are to be filled out online when you register for the race on <a href="#">AdminSkiRacing   America's largest ski race and event platform</a> . <b><u>You must have a signed liability release form to race.</u></b>

<b>Waiver</b>	Northstar Resort requires that all Parents/Guardians sign a waiver for each competitor that participates in each race. This is separate from the release of liability linked above. <u>Both need to be filled out to compete.</u>  Resort waiver <a href="#">LINK HERE.</a>
<b>Race Documents</b>	We have set up a WhatsApp's channel for all coaches. This link will be emailed to the <b>coaches only</b> . Please do not share with athletes or parents.
<b>Team Captain's Meeting</b>	<b>Friday, March 6<sup>th</sup> , 2026 at 4:30pm PST. This will be a Teams meeting.</b> The link will be sent out to all coaches registered.  <b>All coaches</b> need to register for the event via online registration no later than <b>Wednesday, March 4<sup>th</sup> , 2026, by 11:59pm.</b>
<b>Lift Tickets</b>	Lift tickets can be purchased at the Season Pass office located in the Northstar village. It will <b>Open at 8:25 AM.</b>  <b><u>Athlete Event Day lift tickets:</u></b> 13 years of age and up:\$66.00 12 years of age and under: \$.46.00.  <u>An Additional waiver will need to be signed at the ticket office.</u>
	<b><u>Parents/ NON Racer/ Spectator Tickets</u></b> Adult: \$84.00; Teen/ Senior: \$66.00; Child: \$46.00  <u>These will be available at the ticket office when you purchase the athlete tickets for race day only.</u>  <u>To avoid the possible long lines, you will be able to purchase tickets the day prior as well as on Race Day.</u>
<b>Schedule</b>	<b>Saturday March 7<sup>th</sup> ,Sunday March 8<sup>th</sup> and Monday March 9<sup>th</sup> , 2026</b> <b>North Series Super G</b>  <b>Saturday March 7<sup>th</sup> – Speed training day (required)</b> <b>Sunday and Monday, March 8<sup>th</sup> –9<sup>th</sup> – Super G</b>  Specific event schedules will be released at the coaches meeting on March 6 <sup>th</sup> .
<b>Bibs</b>	<b>Bib pickup will be at 7:15 AM March 7<sup>th</sup> ,</b> in the competition services office located next to the Northstar Sports Demo Center.

**Alpine coaches will pick up bibs and distribute them to their athletes for each race and return at the end of the weekend. Teams will be charged \$50 fee for any non-returned bib**

**Awards** The Awards will be hosted at the Overlook located in the Upper level of the Northstar Village above the ice rink.
