Entry Deadline	<p>11:59pm Sunday, March 8th, 2026, is the deadline for registration.</p> <p><u><i>\$40.00 Late fee will be applied after the Sunday deadline until 11:59pm Wednesday, March 11th, 2026.</i></u></p> <p>No entries are accepted after the March 11th deadline. Liability Release Form	Release of Liability forms are to be filled out online when you register for the race on AdminSkiRacing America's largest ski race and event platform . <u>You must have a signed liability release form to race.</u>
Waiver	Northstar Resort requires that all Parents/Guardians sign a waiver for each competitor that participates in each race. This is separate from the release of liability linked above. <u>Both need to be filled out to compete.</u> Resort waiver LINK HERE.
Race Documents	We have set up a WhatsApp's channel for all coaches. This link will be emailed to the coaches only . Please do not share with athletes or parents.
Team Captain's Meeting	Friday, March 13th , 2026 at 4:30pm PST. This will be a Teams meeting. The link will be sent out to all coaches registered. All coaches need to register for the event via online registration no later than Wednesday, March 11th , 2026, by 11:59pm.
Lift Tickets	Lift tickets can be purchased at the Season Pass office located in the Northstar village. It will Open at 8:25 AM. <u>Athlete Event Day lift tickets;</u> 13 years of age and up:\$66.00 12 years of age and under: \$.46.00. <u>An Additional waiver will need to be signed at the ticket office.</u> <u>Parents/ NON Racer/ Spectator Tickets</u> Adult: \$84.00; Teen/ Senior: \$66.00; Child: \$46.00 <u>These will be available at the ticket office when you purchase the athlete tickets for race day only.</u> <u>To avoid the possible long lines, you will be able to purchase tickets the day prior as well as on Race Day.</u>
