ENTRY DEADLINE	Entry deadline, February 1, 11:59pm. Entries after this date will be assessed a \$40 late fee. No entries will be accepted after February 5, 11:59pm. Any pulls to the entry deadline must go through the race organizer, allowing further athletes to register. Pulls after the Team Captains Meeting will not be refunded.
ENTRY FEE/ WAIVER	Entry fee is \$38 per Slalom race. Athletes and coaches must register via www.AdminSkiRacing.com by February 1, 11:59pm. No on-site registration. Signed waivers are required and must be completed when registering.
RACER LIFT TICKETS	\$70.00 Youth Lift Ticket (13yrs -18yrs), Child Ticket is \$43.00, and Parent ticket \$125.00. Once you register for the race the link for day of race tickets will be emailed to you. MUST PURCHASE TICKETS by February 6th at 11:59pm. If you have valid IKON pass you don't need to purchase lift ticket.
TICKET PICKUP	Athletes and parents pick up their pre-purchased tickets at the main ticketing window open at 7:30am on Race Days. No walk-up Lift Tickets can be purchased at the Window. Tickets can be printed out in the Kiosk in front of ticket office.
BIBS	Bib pickup by Team Coach at 7:30am morning of race at the Upstairs Competition Service Race Central Office. Bibs must be turned into bins at finish arena at the end of race. Missing bib fee is \$75.00.
TEAM CAPTAIN'S MEETING	February 6, at 5:00pm. In person in Alpen Glow Room located in the Palisades Village across from CoffeeBar or via Zoom.. TCM time will be posted on the program. Invite sent 30 minutes prior to TCM.
AWARDS	1 st -5 th place by gender at the Alpine Race Shack, awards approximately 1hr after final racer on February 8.

Only U.S. Ski and Snowboard officials working the race and registered athletes are allowed in the race venue.
