Please use Glade (adjacent trail on the skier's right) for warm-up, and Chute for equipment/coats transport - no unnecessary movement on the hill. No unnecessary movement on the hill will be allowed **Coaches are asked to slip the course before the awards.** Referee reports for DSQs are officially posted on the timing shack and also unofficially shared on WhatsApp. Protest fee: \$50. TICKETS: Berkshire East and Unlimited Summit Passes work. Discounted lift passes (20% off the window rate) for families will be available; inform staff at the ticket window.</p>
