<p>As racers arrive, please follow the directions of the Mohawk parking crew. Access the Lodge via the Bridge along the walkway from Lot 2. Staging area on-snow to the left of the patio. RFID Lift tickets picked up by head coach 6:45 AM-7:15 AM and distributed to racers and coaches in the staging areas outside on the patio. Make sure to keep lift tickets inside the race suit. Leave gear bags in your cars <u>OR</u> at the free bag check in the lower level of the lodge. Protests against DSQs may be made verbally, with a \$50 Protest Fee to any Jury Member. Race Times will not be published immediately but will be available at Live-Timing.com after the conclusion of each run.</p> <p>http://livetiming.com Official Notice board is at the timing shack by the finish line. Disqualifications (RF Report) will be posted on the timing building and also published to WhatsApp. Other pertinent information will be distributed by PA announcements and on WhatsApp. If internet is unavailable, we will radio DSQ's to coaches. Spectators are only allowed at the finsh area, approximately 20 min walk across snow covered pathway. Live Video Feed of the race will be available in the lodge.</p>
