Awards: Awards will take place outside behind the Main Lodge near the Fire Pit. We will recognize the Top 10 and award the Top 5 in each age class and gender. As per the Mountain Council 25-26 guidelines, the awards will be based on the Best one run of the three runs.

Timing: As per NYSSRA guidelines and with the Mountain Council mandated 3-run format, the race will not be available on live timing. We will have an old-fashioned scoreboard available on the side of the race building for your convenience 😊

Protests: Must be submitted in writing at the finish building within 15 minutes of the posting of the referee's report, accompanied by a \$75 protest fee. Jury meetings will be in the timing room above the Race Building.
