ENTRY DEADLINE	Entry Eligibility per Western Region rules/quotas. Green sheets due 7 days prior to race January 22, 11:59pm. No on-site registration. Foreign Entries, due 24 hours prior to Team Captains Meeting (ICR 215.1), please submit to jabbott@palisadestahoe.com .
ENTRY FEE/ WAIVER	\$60.00 per race. All athletes and coaches must register and pay via www.AdminSkiRacing.com by January 22, 11:59pm. Coaches must be on athletes' green sheets.
RACER LIFT TICKETS	Adult \$85.00 (19yrs and up), \$70.00 Youth Lift Ticket (13yrs -18yrs), Child Ticket is \$43.00, and Parent ticket \$125.00. Once you register for the race the link for day of race tickets will be emailed to you. MUST PURCHASE TICKETS by January 25 at 11:59pm. If you have valid IKON pass you don't need to purchase lift ticket.
TICKET PICKUP	Athletes and parents pick up their pre-purchased tickets at the main ticketing window open at 7:30am on Race Days. No walk-up Lift Tickets can be purchased at the Window. Tickets can be printed out in the Kiosk in front of ticket office.
BIBS	Bib pickup by Team Coach at 7:30am morning of race at the Upstairs Competition Service Race Central Office. Bibs must be turned into bins at finish arena at the end of race. Missing bib fee is \$75.00.
TEAM CAPTAIN'S MEETING	January 26 for Men and January 27 for Women, at 5:00pm via Zoom. TCM time will be posted on the program. Invite sent 30 minutes prior to TCM to coaches and officials registered on Admin Ski Racing. All race communication will be posted on Live-Timing and WhatsApp (registered coaches and officials only)
AWARDS	1 st -3 rd U18 and Overall, per gender on the KT Deck. Awards are approximately 1hr after the protest period closes after second race each day.
