1st run inspection:	8:30am

1 st race run:	9:35am (Women / Men)


Run 2:

2nd run will be set directly following completion of first run.
2nd run Inspection will start approximately 1 hour after completion of the first run.
2nd run Course Inspection open for 45 min
2nd run forerunners 5 min after Inspection Closes
2nd race run immediately following forerunners

Awards ceremony will be approximately 45-60 mins after the completion of the last run in front of the covered deck outside of the main lodge. Awards will be given for the top five and hard charger for each gender and age division.

Rules:

- Please use caution if walking to finish area due to public ski traffic on adjacent trails to race course.
- All USSS and NYSSRA rules apply. For details, please review your current USSS and NYSSRA Competition Guides.
- It is the racers responsibility to turn in his/her bib after the second run. Bib collection will take place in the finish area following the second run. If a racer will not compete in the second run, bibs must be returned to the LMSC yurt. **Failure to return a bib will result in a \$50 charge to the racer.**
- All racers must conduct themselves in an appropriate manner. Unsportsmanlike conduct, obscene language or disrespect to race personnel, Labrador Mountain staff, or other skiers will result in sanctioning.
- Racers are entitled to inspect the course prior to each run; however, they may not ski through any of the gates in advance of their run. Side-slipping is acceptable.
- Disqualification (DSQ) and Did-Not-Finish (DNF) assignments will be posted via AdminSkiRacing and posted on WhatsApp. Any protest must be made to a jury member within 15 minutes of the posting. A protest fee of \$50 applies.
- If a racer believes he/she has been interfered with during his/her run, the racer must leave the course immediately, notify the nearest gate judge, then proceed to the finish area and ask to speak to the referee for a re-run. Re-runs are provided on a provisional basis.
