

# MONTAGE MOUNTAIN U12 SLALOM

**Sunday, February 8, 2026**

## ELIGIBILITY

This U12 Slalom race is open **only** to racers from the Eastern/Northeastern Divisions of the **Pennsylvania Alpine Racing Association (PARA)**. **No out-of-division racers are permitted.**

Per PARA rules, **U10 racers may enter U12 races**. Since Montage Mountain is in the Eastern Division, **only U10 racers from Blue Mountain, Jack Frost/Big Boulder, and Montage Mountain** are eligible to register. The race committee has put a limit of 15 male and 15 female U10 racers on a first-come first serve basis.

All racers must complete the **Montage Mountain Consent/Release**, which must be signed online at the time of registration.

⊘ **No on-site, day-before, or race-day registration** (no exceptions).

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## LIFT TICKETS

- U12 Extended Lift Ticket: **\$39**
- Tickets must be purchased online through the **Montage Mountain Resorts website**.
- After purchase, retrieve your lift pass at any resort kiosk using the **QR code** emailed to you.
- Various lift ticket options are available for skiers **age 12 and older**.

If you already have a **Montage RFID card** from a previous season or visit, please reuse it. Otherwise, a **\$6 new RFID card fee** applies.

✉ **Double-check your email address at purchase** to ensure you receive your QR code. Racers must carry their RFID card at all times for lift access (including while wearing a speed suit).

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## PARKING

- **Free parking** is available in the **main parking lot only**.
  - Vehicles are **not permitted** in the lodge drop-off area.
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## RACE READY / STORAGE

- The Main Lodge will be open but offers **very limited storage**.
  - Racers are encouraged to arrive **race-ready** and store personal items in their vehicles.
  - In past seasons, some clubs have rented tents in the **Midland area** for team storage.
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## VOLUNTEERS – REQUIRED FOR THE RACE TO HAPPEN

MMST will enforce a **Clean Course** policy. No walking or skiing spectators will be allowed on the race course.

MMST is a small club and **race-day volunteers are essential**. Parents who wish to be close to the action are encouraged to sign up as **Gate Judges or Course Workers**.

🔑 **Visiting parents who volunteer** will receive a **complimentary lift ticket** when signed up by **Friday, February 6, 2026 (11:59 PM)**.

MMST honors the **PARA Gate Judge Certification Program**.

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## RACE DAY CHECK-IN

- Bib pick-up and check-in will be handled by **one designated coach per team**.
  - Bibs will be pre-packed in envelopes and available on the **porch of the Ski School Chalet**.
  - Racers should collect their bibs directly from their coaches.
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## RACE DAY SCHEDULE

**First Run**

- **7:30–8:00 AM** – TD, Referee, Chief of Race, and Chief of Course review first-run course
  - **7:30–8:00 AM** – Team Captains pick up racer bibs (Ski School Chalet porch)
  - **8:15 AM** – Team Captains Meeting, Referee Update, Coach Ticket distribution (*Outside Main Lodge near Rental Shop*)
  - **8:30 AM** – Iron Horse Lift opens for **Racers, Coaches, and Officials ONLY**
  - **8:30 AM** – Gate Judges & Course Volunteers meet Head Gate Judge on snow (Ski Patrol area)  
(*Must be signed up via TimeToSignUp for volunteer ticket*)
  - **8:40 AM** – Course inspection opens (top of Switch Trail)
  - **9:15 AM** – Inspection closes (top of race course)
  - **9:25 AM** – Forerunners
  - **9:30 AM** – Race begins
    - Female U10, U12
    - Male U10, U12
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## Second Run

- Inspection opens **45 minutes after completion of first run**
  - Forerunners **45 minutes after inspection opens**
  - Second run begins immediately following forerunners
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## AWARDS

- **U10 Female & Male:** 1st, 2nd, 3rd
- **U12 Female & Male:** 1st, 2nd, 3rd

🏆 **Awards ceremony time and location will be announced on race day.**

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## COACHES' INFORMATION

- **Zoom Team Captains Meeting:**  
**Saturday, February 7, 2026 at 8:00 PM**  
Registered coaches will receive the meeting link via email.
- Coaches must stage **on the lift side (skiers' left)** of the course.
- Skiing parents and siblings may view the race from the adjacent trail "**Spike.**"
- For non-scored U12 technical races, **equipment control will be enforced on a protest basis only.**
