- LOCATION:** Snow Summit Mountain Resort
- EVENTS:** February 28 – Women’s and Men’s Slalom  
March 1 – Women’s and Men’s Slalom
- ENTRY FEE:** The entry fee is \$38 per Slalom race. All entries will only be submitted online at AdminSkiRacing. <https://adminskiracing.com>. There will be no on-site registration. Any pulls prior to the entry deadline must go through the race organizer. Pulls after the Team Captain’s Meeting will not be refunded.
- ENTRY DEADLINE:** Entries will open on Monday, February 23, 2026. Due to the short notice, there will be no late fee charged. **All entries will close February 26, 2026 at 11:59 PM. All coaches must register for the event via online registration no later than Thursday, February 26 by 11:59PM.**
- ELIGIBILITY:** **U10 and U12 only.** All participants must have a current Alpine Competitor membership with US Ski & Snowboard and Far West. Please call Member Services at (435) 647-2666 or email [membership@usskiandsnowboard.org](mailto:membership@usskiandsnowboard.org) to verify or update memberships by at least 24 hours prior to the Team Captain’s Meeting.
- LIFT TICKETS:** **Racer** lift tickets will only be available for purchase at the ticket windows and cost \$30 for 11-year-old racers and younger. **Immediate family of registered racer** lift tickets cost \$38 for 5-12 year old siblings, \$65 for 13-17 year-old siblings, and \$75 for 18-64 year-old parents. Family members over 64 will need to show ID for the family senior rate. **IKON passes are valid at Snow Summit.**
- LIABILITY RELEASE:** Online release of liability forms are to be completed when you register for the race at AdminSkiRacing. Racers must have a signed liability release to race.
- TEAM CAPT’S MTG:** Friday, February 27 at 6:00 PM in person or via ZOOM. **Coaches must register for this event** by the entry deadline of February 26, 2026. Registered coaches will receive a link to the meeting.
- BIBS:** **Team Captains will pick up their athletes’ bibs from a table outside the Season Locker Room on February 28, 2026 at 7:30 AM. Athletes will keep the bibs for the series and return them no later than one hour after the last racer on March 1, 2026.** Any athletes who fail to return their bibs will be charged a missing bib fee of \$50.
- RACE LOCATION:** Miracle Mile
- RACE SCHEDULE:** Start times and the Schedule will be determined at the Team Captain’s Meeting. The race Program, Start Lists, and Results will be available on <https://www.live-timing.com/>.
