# REGISTRATION INFORMATION

**Entry Procedure:** All Athletes and Coaches must be registered on Admin Ski Racing prior to the registration deadline to participate in the event.

**Registration Deadline: March 2, 2026**

**Entry Fee: \$75 per event**

(Entry fee DOES NOT include Lift pass. Lift Pass is \$29.16)

**Lift Pass** - IKON or Stratton Mountain pass. **Athletes and COACHES who need a lift ticket to access the mountain will receive a CODE to purchase tickets online** and print a ticket at one of the resort kiosks or Guest Services. **You may purchase a Multi-Day ticket if participating in both events.**

Ticket CODES will be delivered to the email address associated with the athlete's and coach's registration profile AFTER the TEAM CAPTAINS MEETING. CODES can be redeemed via the following Link:

**Important Notes:**

After entering your ticket CODE, the default for number of adults is "2". That can be disregarded. The code will only allow for 1 person to purchase a ticket.

If anyone would like to purchase a multi-day ticket, they can change the number of days by clicking on "change" (indicated by the arrow below). That will allow for them to choose, for example, a 2-day ticket if the event is running for more than 1 day. If they bought day 1 online, and then realize they need a day 2, Guest Services can add the second day at the correct price point as a walk-up.

Tickets will also be available for purchase, morning of, by walking up to Guest Services.

**REFUND POLICY:** Refunds will only be issued if injury or illness occur prior to first day of competition with a note from a doctor or licensed mental health professional. Refunds will be issued if an athlete pays but does not qualify according to regional quota. Please see Guest Services for any refund requests.

### **All Coaches Must Register to Receive a TICKET -**

- 1) Coaches are limited by regional quota of 20 per region (this # is noted in the additional event info)
- 2) Coaches must be named on official entry form in order to register.

**Regional Coaches:** Each region will be given 20 complimentary lift passes (up to 60 total for all regions)

**Award Ceremonies:** The top three finishers of each event will be awarded. Awards presentation across from Mid-Mountain lodge following completion of each race.

**Wax Space:** Stratton Mountain School with prior authorization.


