
Course setters lift: 7:15 am
Registration: 7:30 - 8:00 am (Team Captain team pick-up
bibs and passes in Yurt)
Lift Open for Athletes: 8:15 am

Run 1:
1st Run inspection: 8:30 am start (Women on right, Men on left)
1st Run Course Closed: 9:25 am
1st Run Women forerunners: 9:30 am
1st Run Women: 9:35 am
1st Run Men Forerunner: Immediately after completion of women's run
1st Run Men Immediately after forerunners complete

Run 2:
2nd Run course will be set directly following the completion of the first run
2nd Run inspection start approx 45 minutes after completion of the first run
2nd Run Course Inspection will be open for 45 min
2nd Run forerunners for Women's course 5 min after inspection closes
2nd Run Women's immediately following the forerunners
2nd Run Men forerunners will begin directly after the 2nd women's run ends
2nd Run Men immediately following the forerunners

Awards: Awards will be held approximately 1 hour after the completion of the final run

General Rules:

- The program is subject to changes based on conditions and other factors that are outside of the control of the race officials
- All U.S. Ski & Snowboard and NYSSRA rules apply. For details, please review your current USSS and NYSSRA Competition Guides.
- It is the racers responsibility to turn in his/her bib after the last run. Racers will be assigned the same bib number for the duration of the day. Bib collection will take place in the finish area after the athlete's last run. If a racer chooses to not complete all runs, bibs must be returned to the LMSC yurt. Failure to return a bib will result in a \$40 charge to the racer.
- All racers must conduct themselves in an appropriate manner. Unsportsmanlike conduct, obscene language or disrespect to race personnel, Labrador Mountain staff, or other skiers will result in sanctions.
- Racers are entitled to inspect the course; however, they may not ski through any of the gates in advance of their run. Side-slipping is acceptable.
- Disqualification (DSQ) and Did-Not-Finish (DNF) assignments will be posted via AWhatsApp. Any protest must be made to a jury member within 15 minutes of the posting. A protest fee of \$50 applies.
