Adult Racer \$85.00 (19yrs and older), \$70.00 Youth Lift Ticket (13yrs -18yrs), Child Ticket is \$43.00, and Parent ticket \$125.00. Once you register for the race the link for day of race tickets will be emailed to you. You must purchase tickets by March 11, at 11:59pm. If you have a valid IKON pass you don’t need to purchase racer tickets.

TICKET PICKUP

Athletes and parents pick up their pre-purchased tickets at the main ticketing window open at 7:30am on Race Days. **No walk-up Lift Tickets can be purchased at the Window. Tickets can be printed out in the Kiosk in front of ticket office.**
