LATE ENTRY

DEADLINE: \$5.00 LATE FEE Starts 3 days before the first day of the race series.

REGISTRATION CLOSES 48hrs before the day of the race.

RULES: U.S. Ski and Snowboard rules apply. Qualifier for U14-U18 Western Region Championships.

For Slalom U12 athletes will race in stubbies, U14 athletes will race in 60" tall 27mm gates;

U16/U18 athletes will race in full length 27mm gates.
