ENTRY FEES: \$48.00 per scored event for U16 – SR
\$36.00 per non-scored event for U12 – U14

ENTRY DEADLINE: January 14 for U12-U14 and January 17 for U16-SR.

RULES: U.S. Ski and Snowboard rules apply. Qualifier for U14-U18 Western Region Championships. For Slalom U12 athletes will race in stubbies, U14 athletes will race in 60" tall 27mm gates; U16/U18 athletes will race in full length 27mm gates.
