Events: 1 Giant Slalom & 1 Slalom

Entries: The Finals is a two-day event consisting of Slalom and Giant Slalom races. The event is open to all eligible competitors in the division, but a racer may not compete in another Championship event.

Entry Fee: \$62.00/series \$31.00 /per race payable through <https://adminskiracing.com/>

Entry Deadline: Mar 6th, 2026 (Portal will close at 11:59 pm that day)

PCMR Release: A PCM/Vail Liability Release is required for all competitors, coaches, and volunteers. The Release can be found during the registration process on ASR. All competitors must complete this before the start of the first race. Please do not email the liability release.

Lift Tickets: \$50/day for competitor tickets at Payday Ticket Window - opens at 7:30am. PCM accepts cash and major credit cards. Multi-day passes are available. *Coaches must have current USSA Alpine Coaches Membership and be registered for the event on ASR in order to receive complimentary lift tickets. Coaches Tickets for coaches can be picked up at the finish in the morning during bib collection.*

Bibs: Will be delivered to TC's in the morning of the first race. TC's can pick up the bibs in the finish area with coach tickets. Athletes will only receive bibs with confirmation of registration on ASR. Athletes will return bibs to the finish arena at the end of each discipline and will be redistributed for the new discipline accordingly. Lost or damaged bibs \$50.
