Friday, 1/9/26: Mens/Womens SL- seeded TRS: Run 1- random draw, Run 2- reverse of first run

Saturday, 1/10/26: Mens/Womens SL - Run 3 begins with the 2nd half of the first run and then continues with the first half of the first run order, Run 4- reverse of the 3rd run order.

Sunday, 1/11/26: Mens/Womens GS- seeded by random draw

Awards: Awards will follow the completion of the race, outside Lodge Room at the base area, awards will be presented to top 5 overall athletes. Mens/Womens GS- seeded by random draw

Bib Draw: The draw will be presented over a shared screen at daily TCM. The TRS draws will be done in Split Second for the entire field. It will be presented over shared screen at daily TCM
