

**BOGUS BASIN SPORTS EDUCATION FOUNDATION  
ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE OF LIABILITY, PARENTAL CONSENT  
AND MEDIA RELEASE (MINOR PARTICIPANT)  
THIS DOCUMENT AFFECTS YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS. READ CAREFULLY BEFORE AGREEING.**

In consideration of allowing the minor participant identified in the associated registration record ("PARTICIPANT") to participate in training, summer training camps, competitions, events, fundraisers, skiing, snowboarding, mountain biking, biking, cycling, dryland training, strength and conditioning programs, trampoline or gym training, travel to and from Activities, and all activities sponsored, organized, hosted, or sanctioned by Bogus Basin Sports Education Foundation and/or Bogus Basin Recreation Association (collectively "BBSEF"), the undersigned parent or legal guardian agrees as follows:

The undersigned acknowledges that skiing, snowboarding, competition, training, and related alpine, nordic, freestyle, freeski, big mountain, adaptive, snowboard, mountain biking, dryland, strength, conditioning, trampoline, gym, and travel activities (collectively "Activities") involve inherent and ordinary risks. These risks include, but are not limited to, changing weather and surface conditions; terrain variations; natural and man-made obstacles; jumps and terrain features; equipment failure; collisions with persons or objects; being struck by skiers, riders, cyclists, or equipment; transportation-related incidents; and exceeding one's abilities. Risks also include riding, loading, and unloading chairlifts and surface lifts; lift stoppages or evacuations; course design; race gates; safety netting; timing equipment; bike terrain features; and other competition or training infrastructure. Serious injury, permanent disability, paralysis, or death may occur.

The undersigned understands that supervision, coaching, instruction, and enforcement of rules by BBSEF do not eliminate risk and cannot guarantee safety. The undersigned further represents that the PARTICIPANT is physically and mentally fit to participate in the Activities and has no medical condition that would prevent safe participation, or that any such condition has been disclosed and appropriate clearance has been obtained.

With full knowledge of these risks, the undersigned, on behalf of the PARTICIPANT and in his or her individual capacity, voluntarily and expressly assumes all risks associated with participation, whether known or unknown, including risks arising from the active or passive negligence of BBSEF, including any negligent rescue or emergency response, to the fullest extent permitted by Idaho law.

The undersigned WAIVES, RELEASES, AND DISCHARGES BBSEF from any and all claims, demands, causes of action, damages, losses, or expenses (including attorneys' fees) arising out of or related to the PARTICIPANT'S participation in the Activities, including claims based on negligence, except where prohibited by law, and further agrees to DEFEND, INDEMNIFY, AND HOLD HARMLESS BBSEF from any claims brought by or on behalf of the PARTICIPANT or any third party.

The undersigned authorizes BBSEF to obtain emergency medical treatment for the PARTICIPANT if deemed necessary and agrees to assume financial responsibility for such care. Medical information may be disclosed as necessary to provide or coordinate care consistent with HIPAA and applicable law.

The undersigned grants BBSEF permission to photograph, video record, and otherwise capture the PARTICIPANT'S likeness during participation in Activities and to use such images or recordings for legitimate promotional, educational, fundraising, or informational purposes in print, digital, or social media formats without compensation and waives any right to inspect or approve such use.

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Idaho. If any provision is held unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

The undersigned certifies that he or she is the lawful parent or legal guardian of the PARTICIPANT identified in the registration record, has authority to execute this Agreement, understands that it is binding upon the PARTICIPANT and all parents or legal guardians, and agrees to indemnify BBSEF from any claim that such authority was lacking.

The undersigned acknowledges having carefully read and understood this Agreement and agrees to its terms voluntarily.

Electronic acknowledgment, including checking an agreement box or completing registration, constitutes a legally binding electronic signature under the Idaho Uniform Electronic Transactions Act and the federal E-SIGN Act.
